COMPANY PROFILE

THE BIRTH OF JAK127

2019 - 2020

During 2007, Hennie van Vreden, who was then employed by the SAPD as a member of the Occult Unit of the North-West Police and also acted as a negotiator, experienced the Lord calling him to resign. Shortly afterwards he joined a team on a mission trip during which they visited 13 countries on 4 continents. Embarking on the journey they were sent out with the passage in James 1 verse 27.

During the mission trip, while sleeping at an orphanage in India one evening, Hennie experienced the Lord instructing him to establish an organisation to help people in need. Confirming this instruction, Hennie noticed a water tanker in the street the next morning with the scripture James 1 verse 27. He knew it was a sign from God.

OUR DNA

During the previous centuries, it was mainly churches (congregations and synods) that sent missionaries to territories or that provided assistance to people in need.

During the last part of the last century, however, separate mission organisations emerged that functioned independently of any congregation. Jak127 is convinced that the command in Matthew 28: 19-20 was given to all children of the Lord and that it is the church's most important command to go out into the world and to teach them to follow God, and to baptize them in the Name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.

The mission can therefore not be separated from the church. The church (congregation) should serve as a base where members are prepared and equipped for mission and where resources are obtained. The congregation also plays an important prayer role with regard to and during missionary actions.

Although Jak127 is inter-denominational, a deliberate decision was made not to function independently of the church and each office of Jak127 is in a very definite relationship with a specific congregation in the town / city where the office's is based.

THE CALLING

Jak127 was called according to the passage in James 1 verse 27 to assist people in need. The actions of Jak127 are based on Matthew 25: 35-36. "For I was hungry, and you gave Me something to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me something to drink; I was a stranger, and you invited Me in; I was naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me [with help and ministering care]; I was in prison, and you came to Me."

James 1:27

"Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world .. "



PROJECTS / PROGRAMS

People's basic needs are mentioned in Matthew 25: 35-39 and can be of a physical and / or spiritual nature. The projects and actions of Jakl27 during 2019/2020 are discussed according to these needs:

SPIRITUAL ACTIONS

MEN'S MINISTRY

Three men's camps were held during the year. During these camps, the focus was on God's heart and calling for men.

YOUTH MINISTRY

This ministry included the following actions:

- Youth Evenings hosted at schools in Victoria West, Carnarvon, Williston and Fraserburg.
- Schools visited in Sutherland, Carnarvon, Victoria West and Murraysburg.
- Danny Arendse's youth ministry supported in Paarl East.
- Bible studies presented at schools in Klerksdorp.
- JOT (Jesus Our Teacher) presented at Nico Malan High School in Humansdorp.
- Hennie also acted as the chaplain of Nico Malan High School's rugby teams.









NIGHT OF BECOMING

During the event hosted in Paarl in the form of a formal dinner, an opportunity was created where father's could pray a fatherly blessing on their daughters (14 years and older). The occasion served as a celebration of the fact that the daughter is now a young women.





FARM VISITS

During the drought in the Karoo, 40 farmers and their farm workers where visited to encourage them during the drought.



PROJECTS / PROGRAMS

HOSPITAL MINISTRY

The Klerksdorp team visited the Oncology and Maternity wards at local hospitals in Klerksdorp.

The aim is to support the patients with;

- · Prayer;
- The giving of care packets for new moms;
- And to bless each patient with a Bible.

STEERING WHEEL

During July 2019, an outreach was held in collaboration with Highway Ministries to serve the truck drivers at Beit Bridge border post. A CD compiled by Jakl27 that share the Gospel within the context of truck driving where handed out. In cooperation with Radio Pulpit a counseling hotline is available to the truck drivers.







KALEIDOS

The Kaleidos ministry is supported by Jak127. The ministry was involved in the following actions:

- The development of a marriage course.
- Presenting a marriage seminar.
- A discipleship course with 12 women.

RED FROGS

During December 2019 we partnered with Red Frogs for Matric Rage Jeffery's Bay. RF presence at these events goes a long way in preventing some of the incidents that occur in these kind of partying environments. Our crew serve thousands of Matrics by handing out legendary Red Frog Sweets, making tons of free pancakes, making sure people are hydrated and getting home safe after the party.

TURKEY & EAGLES

Turkey and Eagles is a board game that focuses on our identity in Jesus. Jak127 supports the initiative and acts as a facilitator at some of the events. Jak127 also uses Turkey and Eagles at ministry events.

INDIA PASTOR TRAINING

Due to Jak127's involvement with Emmanuel's Orphanage, one of the leaders from the orphanage requested the training of 70 pastors of the Araku valley.

In January 2020 Hennie spend 10 days presenting training sessions to the pastors.







PHYSICAL PROJECTS / ACTIONS

SOUP KITCHENS / FEEDING PROJECTS

- Jak127 supported soup kitchens and nutrition projects in Paarl and the Karoo on an adhoc basis.
- Danny Arendse held a monthly service for homeless people in Paarl East during which they receive a meal. Jak127 supported this action financially.
- Sandwiches were provided daily to children at two schools in the Klerksdorp area.

ANSWERING THE CALL DRAKENSTEIN

Jak127; Valcare; Respond and Thubalethu Community Chaplaincy along with other interested stakeholders co-founded *Answering The Call*. The project focuses on supporting disaster victims in collaboration with the Drakenstein Municipality and various schools, businesses and churches in the area.

Answering the Call assisted victims of 10 incidents with the provision of clothing, blankets, food and building materials while equipment was also made available for meal preparation.







STUDY PROGRAMME

This project focused on the support of

- Two high school students by paying their hostel fees. They both have been supported from their first year in high school and is currently in grade 12.
- Two students at the NWU, Potchefstroom Campus. Both these students has been supported from their first year and are currently in their final year.

BUSINESS PLANS

- Jak127 supported the ACVV in Cradock with the planning of an orphanage.
- The Grape Community was supported by the writing of a business plan for EDC's in Paarl and De Doorns.

KS2018

This project focused on supporting farms and agribusinesses with the provision of agri-economic advice.













KAROO DIESEL

This project focused on supplying diesel to farmers in the Karoo.

VAN WYKSVLEI WATER

Van Wyskvlei is located in the Karoo about 70 km north of Carnarvon. Due to the drought, water is supplied to residents as they were limited to 25l per family per day. Jak127 coordinated a water project and 5l bottles were distributed to the locals.

- A treat pack was handed out to the pupils during the November 2019 examination in collaboration with Helderberg Outreach.

KAROO FARMER WIVES PAMPER PACKS

Jak127 supported the pampering package projects for the wives of the farmers in the Karoo and was involved in the following actions:

- In collaboration with Every Nation Paarl, parcels are distributed in Calvinia and the Bushmanland during the farm visits.
- In collaboration with City of Hope, parcels were distributed to the farm workers in Calvinia and in the Bushmanland during the farm visits.
- Logistical support was provided to the Strooidak Congregation and the VLV with their projects.
 Parcels where taken to Fraserburg and Beaufort West.
- Parcels were distributed in collaboration with the Secund Reformed congregation in Van Wyksvlei.







CORPORATE ACTIONS

- During 2019/2020, Dr Charl van der Merwe was appointed Managing Director of Jak127.
- Calvinia office became operational from 1 November and is responsible for managing actions in the Karoo.
 Johannes and Yvonne Esterhuize manages the Calvinia office.
- Jak127, Valcare; Respond and Thubalethu Community Chaplaincy, along with other interested stakeholders cofounded Answering The Call. This network focuses on supporting disaster victims in the greater Drakenstein area.
- Jak127 is currently in the process of establishing an office in Germany and is also investigating the possibility of opening an office in Australia.
